Would you like to learn to play a string instrument?

Grade 4 students are invited to participate in Halifax Regional Arts (HRA) String Music Program. Classes are offered in violin, viola, or cello, depending on your location and teacher. These classes start in the Fall, however, you need to register NOW. Space is limited so please register soon at the link below

What do I need to know?

Lessons are FREE and students are expected to attend lessons twice a week. Instruments are available at no cost while your child is participating in the program. We will also provide the music. You will be contacted in the fall, as long as you've registered online, with details about the program, whether the class is full or not, and where and how to get an instrument.

Where are string lessons held? What instrument is available? It depends!

Where the lessons are held depends on where we have teachers, what school your child attends, and what instrument is offered. For many schools string classes are offered at the school. These classes take place during the school day with one lesson during class time and the other is held either before school, at lunch time, or after school. For those schools that do not have a string program in their school, there are alternate locations.
